

COVID-19 Rapid Testing

BinaxNow COVID-19 rapid antigen testing will be available on-site at EGUSD schools for symptomatic students. COVID-19 rapid testing will help with rapid contact tracing and prevent possible spread at schools. Parents/guardians must provide written consent for their student(s) to be tested. You can find the consent form [here](#). The form only needs to be completed once, but parents/guardians will be notified prior to each test administered. If you would like to sign the consent form ahead of time, please print, sign, and return to your student's school. Consent forms will also be available to complete at school sites. **You can also fill out the COVID-19 Rapid Testing Online Consent Form, instead of using the printable form to save you a trip to our school site.**

We can offer students and staff the BinaxNOW rapid tests on-site when students are already on campus and develop COVID-19 symptoms throughout the day. We also can offer it to students who are on campus and were in close contact with a positive case. **We cannot not test students who are at home sick as we do not want to invite individuals who we know are sick on to campus, potentially exposing others. If they are already off-campus, they must be referred out to their physician or a community testing site.**
